Elementary School Inclusion

Mission:

The goal of the inclusion program is to provide, students with disabilities, support in the least restrictive environment, which is the regular education classroom with their peers. Students may receive services through co-teaching, check- in support, or a combination of both.

Co-teaching

- A special education and regular education teacher instruct a subject together
- Accommodation and modifications made to grade level curriculum
- Flexible small group instruction within the class for all students
- Differentiation for all students
- One consistent special education teacher per grade
- Additional therapies based on individual need
- Use of assistive technology as needed
- Access to reading and math intervention groups
- Access to reading and math alternative groups as determined by IEP teams

Check-in services

- A special education teacher or paraprofessional consult with the teacher and provide accommodations and modifications
- One consistent special education teacher per grade
- Therapies based on individual need
- Use of assistive technology as needed
- Access to reading and math intervention groups
