Student Assist Center (SAC)

The Student Assistance Center is one of the services provided within the district's inclusion program. It is taught by the students' special education liaison.

Mission:

The goal is to provide daily individualized academic and organizational supports for students with learning disabilities in order to help them be successful in their general education classes.

Components of the class may include:

- Opportunities for re-teaching and pre-teaching
- Academic and organizational supports based on individual needs
- Preparation for tests and long-term projects
- Support in creating tools such as study guides, flash cards, webs, and charts
- Extended time opportunities for test taking
- Remediation sessions prior to retaking a test or quiz
