The Leadership Licensure Program is a unique program offering the following licenses:

- ◆ Principal/Assistant Principal Pre-K–6; 5–8; 9–12
- ◆ Supervisor/Director including Director of Guidance

The LLP is a highly selective licensure program that combines rigorous academic and performance standards with extensive support for participants from Massachusetts Secondary School Administrators' Association, Teachers²¹, Massachusetts Association for Supervision & Curriculum Development and the Massachusetts Association of School Superintendents during the instructional program, the practicum and the first year of employment as a school administrator.

Up to thirty credits are available to participants through our partnership with Endicott College. Qualified candidates may also elect to apply the 30 credits earned toward partial fulfillment of the requirements for a Master of Education in Organizational Management from Endicott College. An additional two courses must be completed for a Masters degree. These courses are offered at the MSSAA office.
