- An \$15 EXTRA FEE is required for certain trips (6 trips)
- Register by the day, week or entire summer

All YMCA programs follow the Healthy Eating and Physical Activity (HEPA) standards. Please make sure you send your child in with a healthy breakfast, snack or lunch that align with these standards.

# REGISTRATION & ENROLLMENT & PAYMENT

1. Please complete the registration form, circle the town your child goes to school in, that is the Fun Club they will be attending, and circle the days needed. Each child needs a separate registration and enrollment form with a \$25 Registration Fee per child.
2. Information forms and enrollment packets will be sent to you via email, upon receipt of registration and first week in advance payment. Registrations will not be processed without payment.
3. Send check and registration form to Old Colony YMCA: CBCC, 200 Hedges Pond Road, Plymouth, MA 02360 Attn: CBCC - and the name of the town.
4. REFUND POLICY: No refunds will be made due to failure to attend, or inclement weather. All fees are non-refundable with the exception of a note from a physician stating your child cannot attend program for medical reasons.
5. Payment is due prior to your child attending the program. No child will be admitted to program if there is an overdue balance. Changes in scheduled days must be submitted 2 weeks prior to the change and must be made through our office. 508-833-4796. No switching of days is permitted.
6. The EEC enrollment packets and information forms must be filled out and returned 2 weeks prior to your child attending the program.
7. Field Trips are subject to change. As much advance notification as possible will be given in the event of a change or addition. Check parent board or call for updates.
8. A fee of \$20.00 will be charged for NSF transactions.

**PROGRAM OPERATION** - The Old Colony YMCA Summer Fun Club (SFC) program hours are from 7AM - 6PM, Monday thru Friday. Our programs are licensed by the Department of Early Education and Care (EEC) or the MA Board of Health. A healthy breakfast is served at 8am and afternoon snack is served daily and provided by the YMCA. The staff to child ratio on site days is 1:13 and field trip days are 1:10. Pre-registration and payment according to the payment schedule in the brochure is required. ALL SITES ARE CLOSED JULY 4TH.

**ENROLLMENT PACKET AND ADDITIONAL FORMS, WILL BE SENT ONCE YOU ARE REGISTERED** - Please complete the enrollment packet, and return 2 weeks prior to the first day your child will attend. Every child is required by EEC to have an enrollment packet and physical on file with the SFC. Make sure to list any medical issues, allergies, medications or any other concerns or issues that will help us provide quality care for your child on the form. Any child with an allergy, special condition or medication will not be permitted to attend until all paperwork is completed and medications are at site.

**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE** - Financial assistance is available to families that qualify. A financial assistance application MUST be submitted and approved by May 30<sup>th</sup>. The process does take some time, so please call our office for the application before hand. You must be approved prior to enrollment, otherwise, you will be responsible for the private fee rate.

**SUMMER THEMES/DEVELOPMENTAL ASSETS** - Exciting themes have been planned throughout the summer. The children will also be learning about the Developmental Assets as well as building their own. Children will participate in crafts, teambuilding, sports, the arts and educational and social skills activities. Please check the Summer Calendar and Family Bulletin Board on site weekly for a list of the upcoming events, or additional information!

**FIELD TRIPS** - Drop off time for all field trip days is before 8am. We will be going on field trips through out the summer as listed in the brochure. You will also need to fill out and sign the Field Trip Permission form. Please note there is an additional fee of \$15.00 for Mystic Aquarium, Canobie Lake Park, Coco Keys, Museum of Science, Davis Mega Maze and Water Wizz trips. Children may bring minimal spending money for gifts shops and concessions when applicable; however, staff will not be responsible for any money sent with the children. Please make sure to check times for field trip departures so your child does not miss the bus. There are **NO** refunds for rescheduled, changed or cancelled trips and trips may be subject to change.

**WHAT YOUR CHILD SHOULD BRING / AND WHAT YOUR CHILD SHOULD WEAR** - Send your children ready for play. Pack a healthy lunch daily for your child (with an icepack) we have no refrigeration, drinks, (no glass bottles, a refillable bottle is advised for water), a change of clothes, swim suits daily, sunscreen and bug spray. Flip-flops and open toed shoes are not permitted for safety reasons. On beach days, children may bring flip-flops to wear at the beach. Your child should come dressed to play. Please be sure to complete all authorization forms. We will be going outside daily, weather permitting, a visor or hat is also suggested. Please send sunscreen daily and bug spray, the Y will not be providing it. No electronics or outside games or toys are permitted.
