


MASSACHUSETTS INSURANCE FUNDING FOR AUTISM WORKSHOP



Over the last 2 years, the Massachusetts Autism Insurance Law (H 4935) requires that most health plans cover treatment for children with autism and related disorders. In addition, the Affordable Care Act exchange plans also cover applied behavior analysis (ABA). The newest development is the requirement for Medicaid Plans to start covering these therapies as well.
