

The Carver Public Schools' Preschool Program, located at the Carver Elementary School, will begin scheduling appointments on Monday, March 19, 2018, for screenings for role model slots for the 2018-2019 school year. Screenings will begin April 6 and continue through May 4.

A screening is required for acceptance into the program. Children considered are those who do not currently receive special education services and are not in need of special education services. Applicants are expected to demonstrate age appropriate skills (within 6 months) in the areas of speech and language, cognitive/school readiness, fine and gross motor development, and social/emotional and behavioral development. In addition, a child must be at least 3 years of age by September 1, 2018 and toilet trained. They must also be a resident of Carver and families must provide transportation to and from the program. Those children found eligible will be entered into a lottery. Appropriate role model students who are not selected in the lottery will be placed on a waiting list. Please note that slots are limited.

This program for role model students is a fee based program. We offer several sessions and the fee for each half day session is \$12.00.
