Publications of the school system will not contain any advertising. However, this will not prevent advertising in student publications that are published by student organizations, subject to administration controls, or the use of commercially-sponsored, free teaching aids if the content is approved by the administration. Solicitation of sales or use of the name of the school system to promote any product will not be permitted by the Principal and/or Superintendent.

REGULATIONS GOVERNING ADVERTISING ON SCHOOL PROPERTY

- All requests for advertising will be made in writing to the Business Administrator. In addition to completing a written application the advertiser will provide a proof of the proposed ad.
- The Business Administrator and Superintendent will review and approve all applications for advertising in the Carver Public Schools.
- No advertisement promoting alcohol, marijuana, tobacco products, and/or any illegal substance will be permitted.
- No explicit material, or material that is discriminatory in nature in terms of race, religion, sexual orientation, gender, or disability will be permitted.
- No political ads will be permitted.
- The district reserves the right to not allow any advertising that conflicts with district policies
 or is determined by the Superintendent or his designee to be inconsistent with the district's
 mission.
- The school district will purchase all signage to ensure the use of uniform materials included in the price. Advertisee will work with Business Administrator on design.
