I hope all is well with you and your family. We look forward to a time when we can all come together again. At this time, the Carver Public Schools are still scheduled to be closed through Monday, April 6th with all students returning to school on Tuesday, April 7th. In the event the Governor decides to extend the closure, we are making plans to develop a more formalized online learning program.

Last Friday, we surveyed the community to determine what students did not have access to a device/computer (other than a cellphone) at home. We plan on distributing Chromebooks to those who do not have device/computer to use at home on Thursday, March 26th. With the goal of maintaining social distancing and keeping any group under 10 people, we will distribute the chromebooks by student's last name following the schedule below.
