GLASS

What To Recycle:

- Clear, green, and brown food and beverage containers only



How To Prepare:

- RINSE CLEAN
- Collars and neck rings DO NOT have to be removed
- REMOVE lids & corks, etc.
- Paper labels may be left on.

Do Not Include:

- Broken glass or other glass items such as window glass, Pyrex, ceramics, etc.
- Light bulbs. Bring fluorescent light bulbs to the recycling center.



METAL

What To Recycle:

- Deposit and non-deposit beverage cans
- Metal food cans
- Aluminum pie plates and trays

How To Prepare:

- RINSE CLEAN
- Crush to save space
- Labels may be left on

Do Not Include:

- Aluminum foil
- Paint cans
- Other metal items
- Aerosol cans
- Chain link fence



PLASTIC

What To Recycle:

- Plastic milk, juice, or water jugs
- Soda bottles
- Detergent bottles
- All plastic containers

How To Prepare:

- RINSE CLEAN
- REMOVE LIDS
- Crush to save space

Do Not Include:

- PLASTIC BAGS
- Motor oil or chemical containers
- Unmarked containers
- STYROFOAM packing peanuts or large pieces

Please recycle

- Boxes (cereal, pasta, toiletries, office supplies, etc.)
- Brochures and filers (Including glossy paper)
- File, folders and manila envelopes
- Mail, magazines, and catalogues
- Newspapers and inserts
- Shredded paper in closed paper bag
- Metal spiral notebooks and writing tablets
- Telephone books

It's Okay To recycle paper with

- Paper clips
- Staples
- Plastic envelop windows
- Self-stick labels

No Thanks

- Candy wrappers
- Envelopes with bubble wrap
- Paper towels, napkins, tissues
- Paper cups, or plates
- Tyvek TM mailing envelopes
- Label backings
- Photographs
