\hookrightarrow Please stay home if you are sick.

\hookrightarrow Please report all positive test results to the school nurse(s):

\hookrightarrow If a student tests positive:

- They <u>mus</u>t isolate at home for 5 days **Note:** Day 1 is the day after you test positive or became symptomatic
- They may return to school on day 6 if they are feeling better and have been fever free for 24 hours
- They must wear a mask in school on days 6-10

→ If a student has been exposed to COVID-19 and is asymptomatic they may attend school.

→ If a student has been exposed to COVID-19 and is not feeling well, they should stay home, test, and contact the school nurse
