↪ **Please stay home if you are sick.**

↪ **Please report all positive test results to the school nurse(s):**

↪ **If a student tests positive:**

- They must isolate at home for 5 days  
**Note:** Day 1 is the day after you test positive or became symptomatic
  - They may return to school on day 6 if they are feeling better and have been fever free for 24 hours
  - They must wear a mask in school on days 6-10
- 

↪ **If a student has been exposed to COVID-19 and is asymptomatic they may attend school.**

---

↪ **If a student has been exposed to COVID-19 and is not feeling well, they should stay home, test, and contact the school nurse**
