We are establishing these goals in support of the District's Educational Blueprint. The Carver School Committee is dedicated to continuous improvement and will collaborate to promote standards to ensure all students become empowered learners and responsible citizens through a comprehensive curriculum that inspires students to learn and think creatively in a safe, supportive and inclusive environment.

Leadership

- The School Committee will work with school administration, in conjunction with Town officials and the community, to develop, approve, and support a responsible funding plan to meet the needs of the District.
- The School Committee will update and revise the Carver Public School Committee Protocols.
- The School Committee will work with the administration to establish means for ongoing assessment of the District's culture and climate, enrollment, and reasons for students seeking other educational opportunities.
- The School Committee will support the administration in developing an action plan to support the effective implementation of the District's Bullying Prevention and Intervention Plan.
- The School Committee will continually review and update the School District Policy Manual in conjunction with the Policy Sub-Committee to ensure that all District policies are in compliance with MA DESE mandates, MA and Federal Laws and best practices for our District.

Communication

- The School Committee will be available for input and feedback from the community and will advocate for Carver students and the Carver Public School District with residents and town leadership.
- The School Committee will support the development of a clear and consistent process for the communication of school information, events, and celebrations across the District.

Professional Development

- School Committee members will participate in at least one professional development opportunity during the school year and report on learning to the School Committee.
- The School Committee will participate in professional development in diversity, equity, inclusion and in creating a safe and supportive school community.

- membership with MASC.
