Foster a sense of belonging in which all members of the school community feel safe, accepted, and valued.

- Select a book narrating the themes of diversity, equity and inclusion for a “one book, one school” project at the middle high school and elementary school.
- Host a book reading/discussion of “We Got This” by Cornelius Minor.
- Develop an E.L. tab on the website.

Diversify faculty, staff, and students through recruitment, retention and promotion.

- Apply for the Teacher Diversification Grant.
- Create and publicize resources on diversity, equity and inclusion to support community growth and learning at home.
- Participate in the Teacher Diversification Professional Learning Community sponsored by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education.
