The Carver Public Schools will be following the guidelines published by the Department of Public Health (DPH) and the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) for the fall return to school that are outlined below:

→ Please stay home if you are sick.

→ Please report all positive test results to the school nurse(s):

→ If a person tests positive:

- They <u>mus</u>t isolate at home for 5 days
 Note: Day 1 is the day after you test positive or became symptomatic
- They may return to school on day 6 if they are feeling better and have been fever free for 24 hours
- They <u>must</u> wear a mask in school on days 6-10
- → If a person has been exposed to COVID-19 and is asymptomatic they may attend school.
- → If a person has been exposed to COVID-19 and is not feeling well, they should stay home, test, and contact the school nurse
