



Carver Middle High School Athletic Code of Conduct for Coaches

Purpose

The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to set clear expectations for high school athletic coaches to ensure a positive, safe, and sportsmanlike environment for all student-athletes, staff, and spectators.

1. Professional Conduct

- Serve as a role model for CMHS student-athletes in behavior, sportsmanship, and integrity.
 - Treat all athletes, officials, colleagues, and spectators with respect and dignity.
 - Maintain professionalism in interactions with players, parents, officials and opposing teams.
 - Refrain from the use of profanity, alcohol, tobacco, or illegal substances during practices, games, and team-related events.
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2. Commitment to Student-Athletes

- Prioritize the safety, health, and well-being of all athletes.
 - Promote academic achievement and support educational goals.
 - Ensure equal opportunities for all students regardless of race, gender, religion, or ability.
 - Encourage good sportsmanship, teamwork, and personal responsibility.
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3. Coaching Responsibilities

- Adhere to all school, district, league, and state athletic association rules and regulations and policies put in place by CMHS Athletic Director.
 - Be punctual and prepared for all practices, games, and team events.
 - Ensure proper supervision of athletes at all times.
 - Maintain up-to-date certifications in CPR/AED and concussion management (as required).
 - Communicate clearly and regularly with players, parents/guardians, and administration.
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4. Communication and Collaboration

- Foster positive communication with student-athletes, parents, school staff, and the community.
 - Used school approved communication methods for updates and team communication.
 - Handle concerns and conflicts professionally and in accordance with school protocols.
 - Support the school's overall educational mission and collaborate with other faculty and staff members.
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5. Discipline and Enforcement

- Set and enforce team rules fairly and consistently.
 - Report incidents of misconduct, abuse, or violations of school policy immediately.
 - Understand that violations of this code may result in disciplinary action, including suspension or dismissal from coaching duties.
