


High Point Treatment Center's Prevention Services mission is to prevent and reduce substance use by increasing awareness, providing education and offering support within the community.



In addition CBHI, BSCS will include an additional service in our CSA program and expanding our services to include Family-Based Intensive Treatment (FIT).

This FIT service will be delivered by a team consisting of a Clinician, a Paraprofessional, and a Family Partner. This team will provide intensive family therapy, care coordination, and Family Partner support over a period of approximately 4-6 months. The goal of FIT is to support the youth and their family in transitioning into less intensive, community-based services.

NFS provides CBHI services to Masshealth eligible clients. CBHI services include In-Home Therapy, In-Home Behavioral Services, Therapeutic Mentoring, Behavior Monitoring, and Therapeutic Training and Support for youth up to the age of 21. NFS may also internally refer families for medication management, outpatient therapy, and ABA services which can be used in conjunction with most CBHI services. For families that require additional support that is not provided by NFS, referrals can be made to other community based agencies. These supports include, but are not limited to, intensive care coordination, family partners, neuropsychological testing, and community based assertive treatment programs. NFS also has a PRIDE team that specializing in supporting LGBT+ identified youth.
