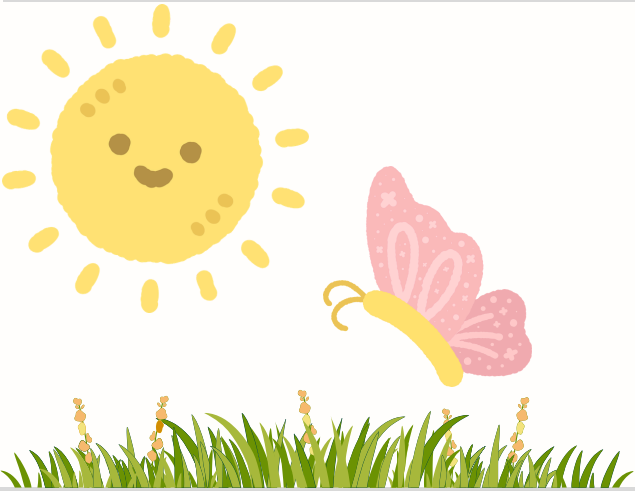

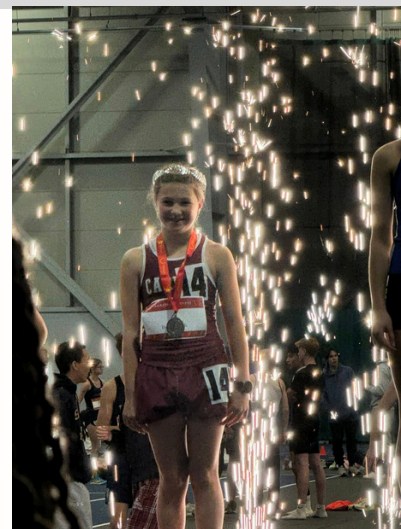

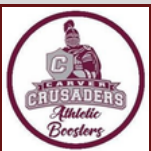

## WHERE DID THAT SPORT COME FROM?

Imagine a sport born not from a stadium, but from a snowstorm and two stolen peach baskets. In 1891, Dr. James Naismith was essentially a desperate babysitter for a class of rowdy college men trapped indoors by a Massachusetts winter. With no fancy equipment, he nailed those baskets to a balcony and tossed out a soccer ball, creating a game so primitive that players had to climb a ladder to retrieve the ball after every single score. It was a chaotic, low-scoring mess that accidentally became a global phenomenon—proving that sometimes the best innovations come from simply trying to keep a group of bored athletes from breaking the gym windows.
