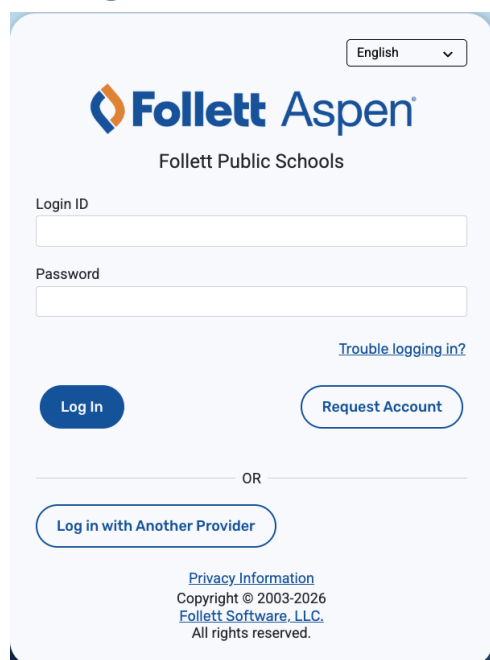
Stay connected to your student's information with Aspen Go, a modern, mobile-friendly experience for families, students, and staff.

What Families Can Do in Aspen Go

With Aspen Go, families can:

- View classes and grades
- Review attendance
- Check assignments and due dates
- See calendar items and events
- View notifications and complete school forms and e-signatures
- Read school announcements and notifications

After you sign in, use the menu to open the areas you need, such as Classes, Attendance, Assignments, Calendar, or Forms.

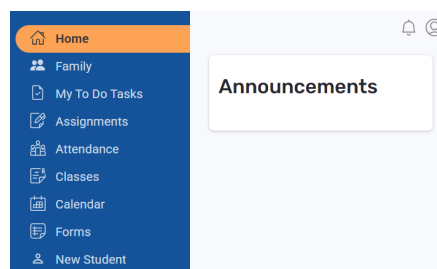
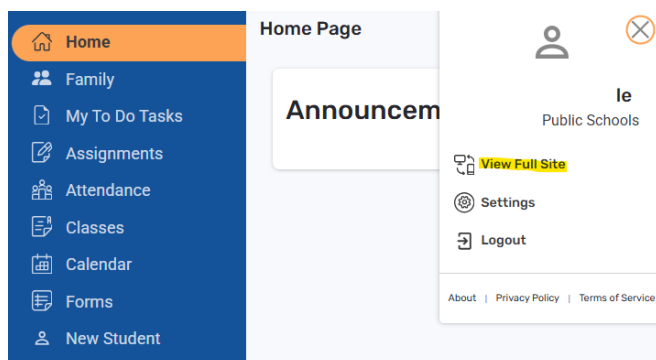


Figure 1: Aspen Go Family Home screen after login.

Password resets and login support are managed by your school district. If you have trouble accessing your account, please contact your school or district help desk or main office for assistance.

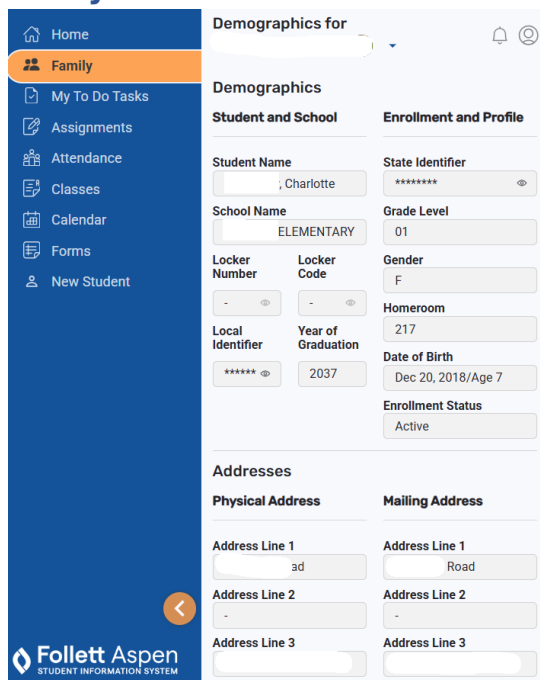
Home

Figure 2: Home screen with student information and navigation menu.

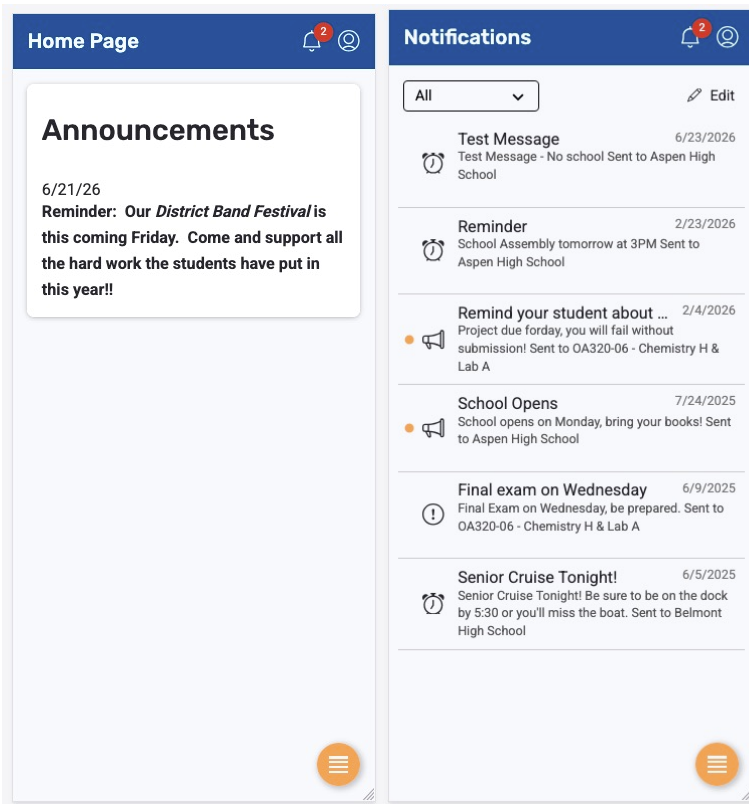
Family



The Family screen allows parents / guardians to see the demographic information about the student. It allows for the selection of the students on which the contact has portal access.

Announcements and Notifications

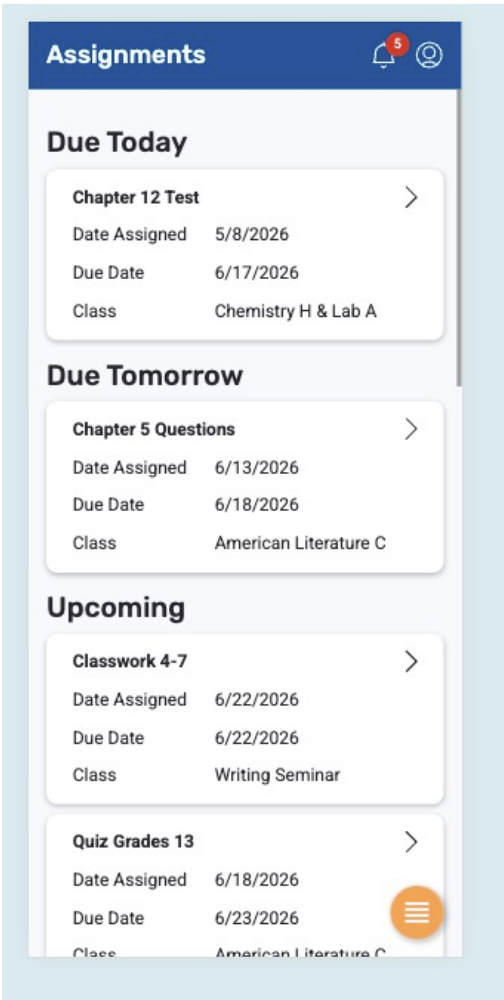


Announcements are posted messages from your school or district that you can read in Aspen Go. View Announcements on the Home screen, where school and district announcements appear in a list

Notifications are alerts in Aspen Go that let you know something new needs your attention. Look for the Notifications icon/menu in the upper right. If a number appears there, it shows you have notifications to review.

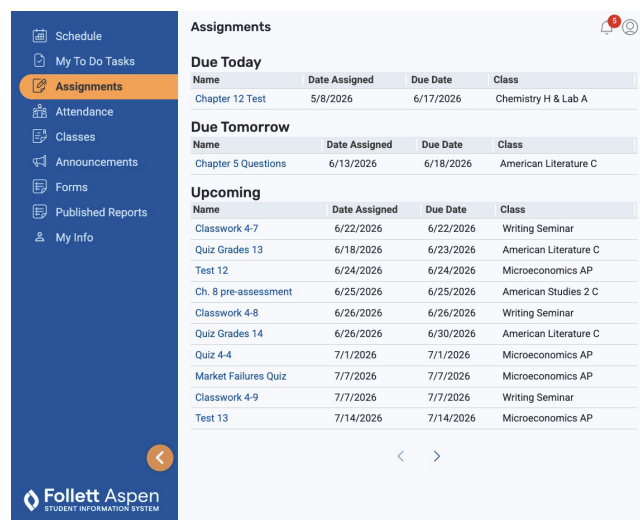

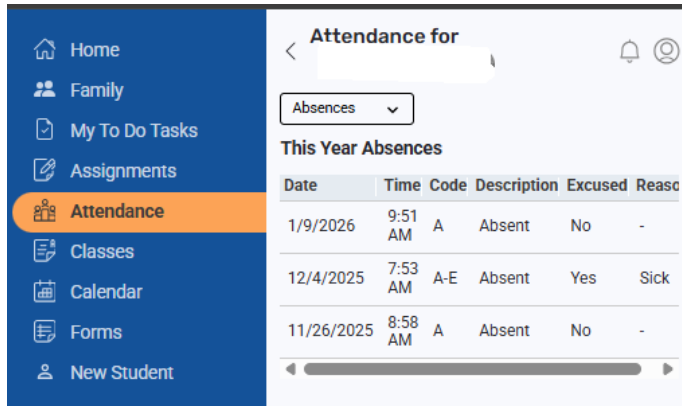

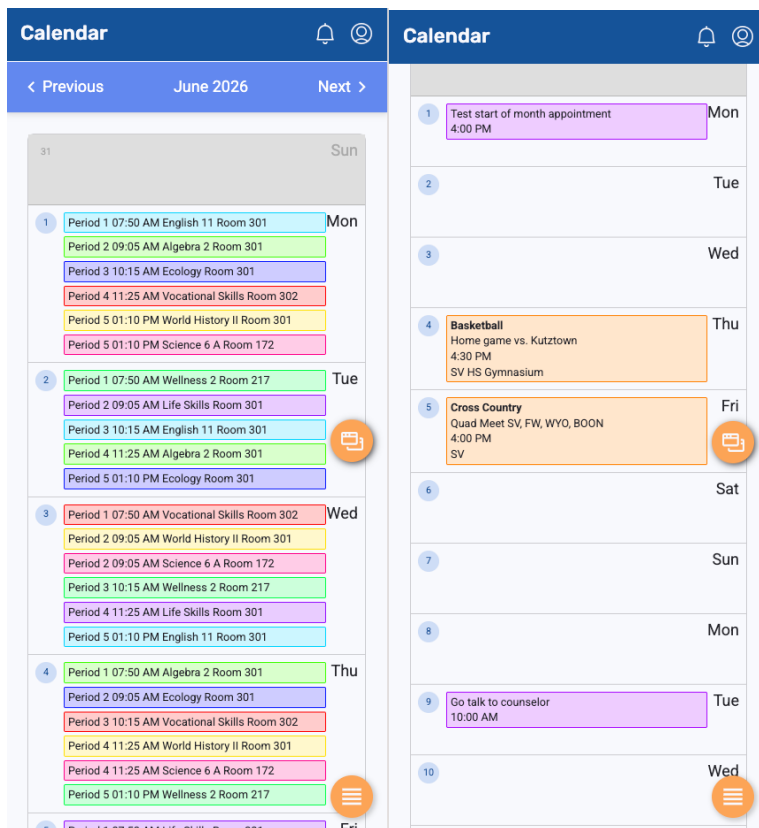
Attendance

Figure 5: Attendance screen showing attendance records.

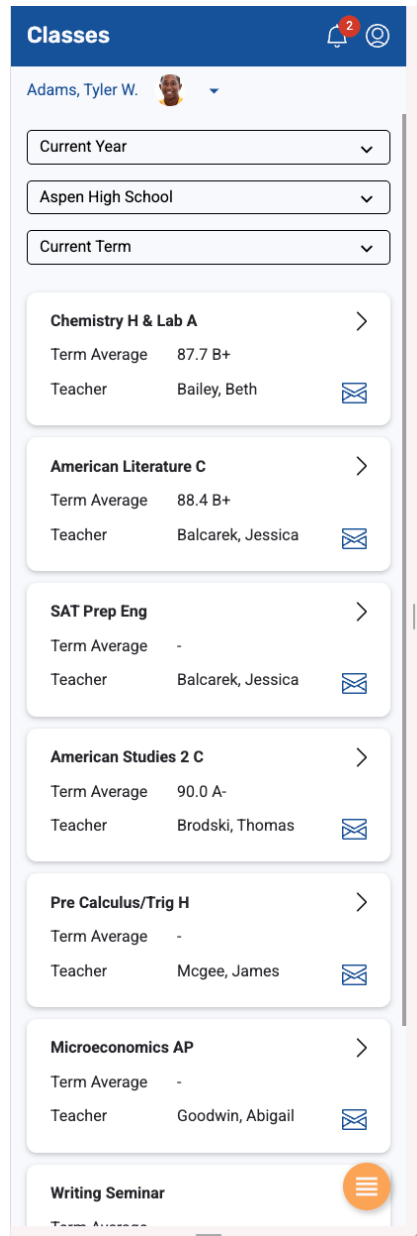
Calendar

Classes



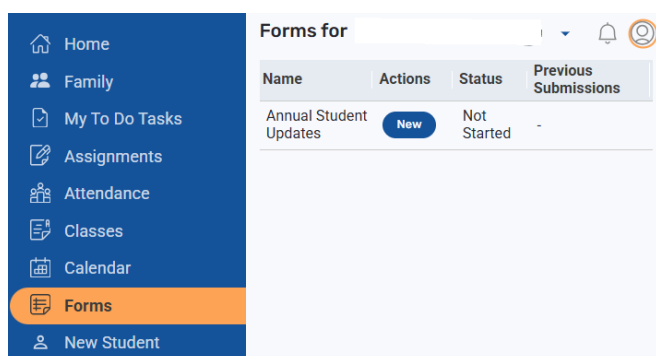
Use Classes to view enrolled classes, teacher names, room information, and current grades.

Published Reports

Use Published Reports to open school documents your district has shared, such as report cards or other posted reports.

Forms



Use Forms to complete registration forms and other school forms online. If your district uses e-signatures, you may also be able to sign forms directly in Aspen Go.

Additional Tips for Families

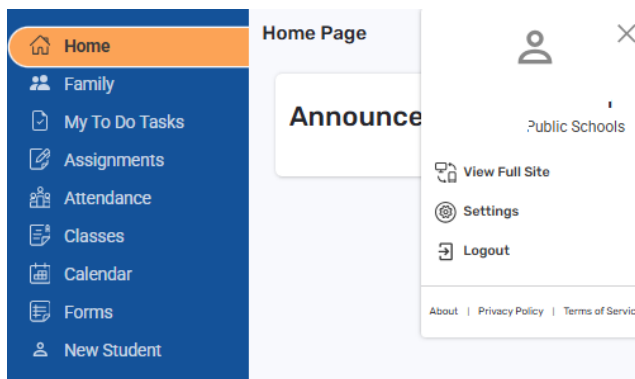
- The exact menu options you see may vary by district and by user permissions.
- Some features may be available in Aspen Go, while others may still open in the full Aspen portal.
- If your district shares report cards or other documents through Published Reports, those items will appear there when they are available.
- If your district uses online forms, you may see registration, back-to-school, or other required forms in Forms.

How to Access the Full Aspen Site

Some districts allow families to move from Aspen Go to the full Aspen site for features that are not available in the mobile view.

To access the full site:

1. Sign in to Aspen Go.
2. Open the main menu in the upper-right corner.
3. Look for an option such as Full Site or Access Full Site.
4. Select that option to open the full Aspen portal.
